1. Citizen	A person who is a legal member of a community	
2. Civic	Related to citizens or what's going on in the community	
3. Constitutional Government	A government that has a constitution to limit the government's power	
4. Civic Participation	Taking a part in the political process	
5. Rights	Protection or benefit guaranteed to a person	
6. Responsibility	An obligation that you can choose to fulfill	
7. Republic	A country that allows the people to elect representatives	
8. Democracy	The people are in charge	
9. Direct Democracy	People control the government directly (no representatives)	
10. Representative Democracy	Citizens choose leaders to make the laws for their countries	
11. Constitution	Legal framework for the government	
12. Higher law	A set of laws the government uses so that one branch doesn't have higher authority over the others	
13. Government	People who make and enforce laws	
14. Monarchy	Government ruled by a king or queen with inherited powers	
15. Constitutional monarchy	A government which has a king or queen AND a constitution limiting his/her powers	
16. Communism	A system where the government owns and controls everything, all property is common to the whole group or country	
17. Dictatorship (authoritarian)	A government with unlimited powers	
18. Totalitarian government	Government has total power over its citizens	
19. Socialism	Advocates control over property and goods to the community as a whole	
20. Oligarchy	System where all power is in the hands of a few, elite people, usually with money	
21. Anarchy	No kind of law or rules at all; a state of chaos	
22. Theocracy	System ruled by a god where a few people interpret the will of that god	
23. Activist	A person who is really active in pushing forward a cause	
24. Volunteer	Someone who gives up their time to service to others	
25. Voting	Formal expression of a choice	
26. Elections	The process of collecting votes for selection of laws and/or leaders	
27. Selective Service	Registered list of all males over 18 who are capable of being called to duty to serve their country	
28. Naturalization	The process by which immigrants become naturalized citizens	
29. Melting Pot	A term used for America—all cultures "melt" into one culture in this country	
30. Assimilation	A process by which people shed their own culture and take on a new one	
31. Immigrant	A person who leaves their country and moves to another	
32. Alien	Someone born in another country who has not gotten citizenship yet	
33. Migration	The act of moving from one place to another	
34. Refugee	Someone who flees their own country because of war or fear	
35. Deportation	The act of being removed and made to leave the country	
36. Patriotism	Pride in your country	
37. Veteran	Someone who has served in the armed forces	
38. Civic virtue	People setting aside differences for the common good in a community
