1. Nicholas Biddle
American banker. Served as president of the Second Bank of the United States. His administration illustrated his belief in the necessity of a central banking institution to stabilize the currency and curb the inflationary tendencies of the era. He became the leading target of the Jacksonians in their war against the bank. When the bank failed of embankment, Biddle opened it as a private bank until it collapsed (1842) in an aftermath of the Panic of 1837.

2. Stephen F. Austin
American leader of colonization in Texas, known as the Father of Texas. Took up the plans to colonize Texas and on a journey there (1821) selected the area between the Brazos and Colorado rivers. He opposed the government of Santa Anna that forwarded the Texas Revolution. Defeated by Sam Houston for presidency of Texas.

3. John Breckinridge
Vice President of the United States (1857-61) and Confederate general. Breckinridge claimed that no power existed in the federal or local government to restrict slavery in any area while it was in territorial status. Believing in secession as a right, he nevertheless disapproved of such a course at that time. Served for the Confederacy after Kentucky declared for the Union and fled to Europe after the war.
